PETA TRANSIT BERINTEGRASI LEMBAH KLANG KLANG VALLEY INTEGRATED TRANSIT MAP





 Credit card from other banks are also accepted in some places of KL like American Express and Union pay. But their popularity is in a smaller scale than that of Visa and Mastercard.

- In addition to cash and card payments, e-wallet payments are increasingly common in Malaysia. The most widely used e-wallet apps are listed above; you can download, register, and link your bank card before your arrival.
- It's important to note that while e-wallet payments are popular, some local shops may still not accept them due to various reasons. Therefore, when exploring Kuala Lumpur, it's advisable to carry at least one card and some cash for your convenience.

Apply for Single Entry Visa (SEV) or <u>eVISA</u> Enter Malaysia and Visit International Student Arrival Centre (ISAC) at the KLIA

Visit Visa Counter and Collect Visa Supporting Documents

> Conduct Post Arrival Medical Examination at EMGS Appointed Clinic

What is **ISAC**?

ISAC is the service centre that operate 24 hours and handles the arrival of all international students before their official entry to Malaysia. Function of ISAC

- To assist and provide the best welcoming experience for international students arriving at KLIA T1 and T2.
- To **check the record** for international students entering Malaysia and act as the reference point for the Immigration Department of Malaysia (KLIA T 1 and T2).
- To **ensure that all necessary documents are sufficient** before submission to Immigration.

Location of ISAC

KLIA T1, Arrival Hall in the main terminal building at Level 3, before the immigration clearance counters.

KLIA T2, Level 3A after the exit from the Skybridge, International Students that arrive in Malaysia on Level 2 will be required to take the passenger lifts to Level 3A.
