STUDENT WELFARE FUND SCHEME (BANTUAN SKIM KEBAJIKAN PELAJAR)

Main focus aids of the scheme:

- Death of student: i) normal/illness RM 3,000.00, ii) accident RM5,000.00 – cash to family members (parents)
- Death of parent/husband/wife/child: RM 2,000.00 – based on student application (death occurred during the study period)
- Natural Disaster: RM 500.00 cash (House partially or completely damage)

Special Case

- Local students Medical costs which are not covered by UM Clinic Guarantee Letter (applicable to admission to the Government, and University Hospital only)
- International students Medical costs which are not covered by Insurance (applicable to admission to the Government, and University Hospital only)
- Learning equipment for disability students.

UNCOVERED MEDICAL EXPENSES

Medical treatment not covered by the Student Health Service Scheme and Student Welfare Fund Scheme are as follows:

- 1. Cost of pregnancy and complications, birth, infertility and family planning.
- 2. Cost for cosmetics or **cosmetic surgery.**
- 3. Cost of organ transplant, bone marrow transplant or dialysis treatment.
- 4. Cost of treatment and hospitalization for medical, surgical or dental cases when occurs abroad.
- 5. Cost of HIV and cancer drugs.
- 6. Costs involving treatment and testing for research purposes.
- 7. Costs of CT scan or MRI scan at CIGMIT PPUM.
- 8. Cost of Recurrent surgery/medical.
- 9. Cost of treatment/medicine for existing disease.

Student Disciplinary Management



University of Malaya (Discipline of Students) Rules 1999

- Rules to control students' disciplines
- Divided into 7 parts:
 - Part I Preliminary
 - Part II General Discipline
 - Part III Hostel Discipline
 - Part IV Road Traffic Discipline
 - Part V Disciplinary Procedure
 - Part VI Appeals
 - Part VII General

PART II – GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- RULE 3: General Prohibitions
- Conduct himself, whether within the Campus or outside the Campus, in any manner which is detrimental or prejudicial:
 - to the interests, well-being or good name of the University, any of the students, staff, officers, or employees of the University
 - to public order, safety or security, morality, decency or discipline



RULE 6: Prohibition against PLAGIARISM

The act of taking an idea, writing, data or invention of another person and claiming as one's own findings or creation Publishes an abstract, article, book which is wholly or partly written by some other person

Extracts academic data which ate the results of undertaken by some other person

Extracts ideas from another person's writing or creation and makes certain modifications without due reference to the original source and rearranges them in such a way that it appears as if he is the creator of those ideas



RULE 8: Conduct during examination

a) take any book, paper, document, picture or other things, into or out of an examination room b) write any information or diagram which may be relevant to the examination on his hand or any otherpart of his anatomy, or on his apparel or clothing

d) cheat or attempt to cheat or conduct himself in a manner which can be construed as cheating or attempting to cheat in an examination

c) communicate with any other student during an examination by whatever means





Shall NOT at all:

13. Organize, carry out or participate in any activity outside the Campus which has a direct adverse effect on the University or which is prejudicial to the interests of the University

17. Any gaming, wagering, lottery or betting within the Campus

18. Consume or have in his possession or behaves in a disorderly manner under the influence or liquor

Shall NOT, **EXCEPT** prior permission from University:

9. Organizing assemblies

10. Possession, custody or control any loudspeaker


11. Make, exhibit, display banners


12. Publish, distribute or circulate any document

These rules are made in accordance with Rule 26, the University of Malaya (Dicipline of Students) Rules 1999. The rules aim to provide guidelines on the appropriate dress code and conduct to be observed by all students of the University of Malava.

PERATURAN | GENERAL RULES

(1) Seliop pelajor diwajibkan MEMAKAI KAD MATRIKS semasa menghadiri/berada di seluruh Pejabat Periladbiran Universiti termasuk dewan kuliah dewan peperiksaan, biik seminar, perpustakaan atau majis POSTRI.

Every student is required TO DISPLAY THEIR MATRIC CARD when affending or when they are present in the vicinity of the University's Administration Offices including lecture halls, examination halls, seminar rooms. Ibraries and in any farmal coremony.


